- § 64.1-1. Virginia Course of descents generally (heirs at law VA from Web First. To the surviving spouse of the intestate, unless the intestate is survived by children or their descendants, one or more of whom are not children or their descendants of the surviving spouse, in which case two-thirds of such estate shall pass to all the intestate's children and their descendants and the remaining one-third of such estate shall pass to the intestate's surviving spouse. Second. If there be no surviving spouse, then the whole shall go to all the intestate's children and their descendants.
- Heirs at law usually include a spouse, children or grandchildren after the law of primogeniture was done away with in Virginia about 1786. (Up to 1786 the Law of Primogeniture existed in Virginia. The widow automatically received 1/3 life interest in the property and the eldest son (the Heir-at-law) received the other 2/3rds. The heir-at-law received the mother's portion at her death. The first grandson gets the next land, not the second son if the heir-at-law dies. The second son gets nothing but personal property. In 1734 all children received something in the will which usually included personal property.)
